TRANSFER STUDENT HOUSING OPTIONS

- 8 residence halls offering community, support, and convenience.
 - Most rooms are triples with bunk beds.
 - A meal plan is included.
- 8 apartment buildings, including Anchor House
 - Fully furnished including kitchens (meal plans available separately).
 - Anchor House is Berkeley's new all-transfer apartment complex with single bedrooms and extensive community amenities, including a Transfer Student Center location.
- **Transfer Hubs:** Live alongside other transfer students on dedicated transfer floors (what we call Transfer Hubs) in Martinez Commons, Blackwell Hall, and Unit 3. Transfer hubs provide built-in support and connection with other transfer students.
- **Family student housing.** University Village in Albany is an apartment community just for students with partners and families.

HOW TO APPLY:

Ready to apply? Here's what to know.

Accept your offer of admission by June 1. You'll be prompted to create a Berkeley campus identification (CalNet ID) which you'll use to access the housing application portal.

Apply for campus housing by June 2 through the housing application portal.

By late June, campus housing offers for transfer students will start to roll out. You will have about 5 days to decide whether to accept your offer.

Affordability & Benefits

What makes campus housing different from off-campus rentals?

- Includes utilities, WiFi, security, maintenance, and more. In residence halls, a meal plan is included too.
- Furnished; laundry access in unit or building.
- Financial aid directly applied to your housing costs.
- Academic year contracts.
- No security deposit.
- No credit checks or need for cosigners.
- Billing through campus system.
- You won't be held responsible if a roommate moves out early.

Note: Family housing apartments are unfurnished and require a \$500 deposit.
